Garment Flipping Machine (model: NF-1010)

Wire Connection Guide

ELECTRIC SAFETY NOTICE

Machine(s) required:

- 1. 2 units of NF-1
- 2. 1 set of NF-1010

Features:

- Two-ways needle detection ensures maximum security
- Garments are turned upside down and by 90 degree
- Fully automatic and care free
- Compatible with any existing needle detectors

Legends:

- (A) machine: infeed machine
- (B) machine: outfeed machine



Caution:


Disconnect all the power plugs before connecting any cables.

Connecting steps


- 1. Open the cover of the control cabinet of (A) machine (see Pic 1).
- 2. The upper flipping machine has two wires: red (N) & blue (M) (see Pic 2).




3. Remove the left relay (Pic 3) of (A) machine by hand to look like Pic 4.




4. Unscrew (X) and take away the original wire (Y). Then, connect the blue wire (M) (see Pic 2) of the upper flipping machine instead. Tighten the screw (X) afterwards.



5. Connect the original wire (Y) with the red wire (N) (see Pic 2) of the upper flipping machine with an insulating tape to look like Pic 7.

Plug back the relay. Then, close the cover of the control cabinet.

Open the cover of the flipping machine control cabinet (see Pic 9).

- 8. Unscrew the cable (G) (see Pic 10). Place cable (G) from position (2) to position (1) to look like Pic 11. Tighten the screw afterwards.
- 9. Close the cover of the control cabinet.
- 10. Plug all the power cables and the machines are now ready to use.
